


1. Do you take mostly a bath or a shower?

- More than 80% answered "shower".
- Portugal answered 100% "shower".




2. Which water do you mostly drink?

- Only the Finnish and the Slovenians prefer “tap”.
- Between 70 and 90% answered “bottle”.




3. What types of waste do you sort at home?

- The Belgians are the ones to have the most balanced sort of waste.
- Italians and Romanians have about 30 till 60% answering “none”.
- Paper, glass and batteries are the type of waste commonly sorted.




4. What types of waste do you sort at school?

- Belgian, Portuguese, Finnish and Slovenian schools sort more types of waste.
- Italian and Hungarian schools have almost no waste sorting.
- Paper and plastic are the type of waste commonly sorted.




5. Do you use second hand schoolbooks?

- About 80% of the pupils use second hand schoolbooks.
- Portuguese and Hungarians answered mostly "no".




6. Do you pay attention on the package of the product when you buy it?

- Most of the answers say "no" (having the Belgians answered about 90%).
- Between 80 to 90% of the Portuguese and Romanians answered "yes".




7. Do you bring your own shopping bag?

- The majority of answers say "yes" (having the Portuguese reached about 90%).
- About 90% of the Belgian and the Italians answered "no".




8. Do you have electricity at a double rate system (night and day) at home?

- The majority of answers say “yes”.
- The Belgians answered 100% “yes”.
- Only the Italians and the Hungarians answered 90% “no”.




9. What kind of tooth brush do you use?

- “Manual” is the most answered option (about 90% of the Finns, Portuguese and Slovenians).
- Belgians are the ones with more users of electrical tooth brush (more than 40%).




10. Do you turn off the TV, computer.... after using it?

- Italians answered 100% "yes".
- Between 60 till 80% answered "yes".




11. How do you mostly go to school?

- Belgians prefer bike (more than 90%).
- Finns and Slovenians prefer public transport (about 50%).
- Italians prefer motorcycle (about 40%).
- Portuguese use car (about 50%).
- Romanians go on foot (more than 70%).
- Hungarians are divided between bike and car (40% each).




12. How many cars does your family have?

- Most of the answers say “2” (having the Italians reached about 80%).
- The majority of Romanians and Hungarians answered “1”.
- Almost 20% of the Finns and Slovenians answered “none”.
- About 40% of the Portuguese answered “more than 2”.




13. How do your parents mostly go to work?

- The majority answered “by car” (between 60 and 100%).
- The second option is “on foot” (between 10 and 20 %).




14. For the choice of your transportation, what is your first priority?

- Belgians and Romanians choose “comfort” (between 50 and 60%).
- Finns, Portuguese, Slovenians and Hungarians choose “time” (between 40 and 80%).
- Italians choose safety (about 50%).




15. What energy do you mostly use to heat your house?

- Belgians, Italians, Romanians and Hungarians use mostly “gas” (between 40 till 100%).
- Finns and Slovenians use mostly “oil” (about 40%).
- Portuguese use mostly “electricity” (more than 50%).




16. What is the temperature in your living room in wintertime?

- The majority answered “21-23 °C” (having the Slovenians reached about 60%).
- Italians and Hungarians answered mostly “18 -22 °C” (40 and 50%).
- Italians have the higher temperatures: “24-26 °C” (more than 25%).
- Portuguese have the lower temperatures: “Less than 15 °C” (5%).




17. Do you have air-conditioning at home?

- The majority answered “no” (having the Belgians and Hungarians reached about 85%).
- Only the Italians have more “yes” answers (more than 50%).



18. How can you regulate the temperature in your house?

- The majority answered "manually" (having the Italians reached about 70%).
- Only Romanians and Hungarians answered "automatically" (between 45 and 55%).
- 5% of the Finns, Portuguese and Slovenians, and about 15% of the Belgians answered "not possible".



19. Do you use rechargeable batteries?

- The majority answered "yes" (having the Romanians reached about 85%).
- Only the Italians have more "no" answers (more than 50%).
